Likewise, your New Villagers Board of Directors acknowledges the existence of some risk involved with the "social" re-opening of our village and our organization. Risk can never be eliminated. So we have targeted our approach to risk mitigation instead. We have worked very hard to craft a re-opening policy that empowers you—our members—to decide how (and if) you can best manage that risk based on your own, unique circumstances. And you have responded enthusiastically!

In June we hosted a series of mini-socials by invitation only for our "New" New Villagers—those who had arrived since the COVID shutdown began. In less than 24 hours, you filled all 80 spots! That response told us that many of you were ready to accept some manageable risk in order to reengage with your community. So, in July we extended our reach to the entire membership (almost 1,000 members) and, again, you responded by filling up 160 spots in a little over 48 hours! Exactly how did we do that?

- Working collaboratively with your POA and HOA leadership teams
- Limiting gathering size consistent with the governor's Executive Orders for Tennessee
- Utilizing outdoor meeting venues
- Observing physical distancing guidelines
- Providing pre-, interim-, and post-event cleaning/sanitizing protocols
- Clear, concise, timely communication with our membership

This month we will once again be offering you the opportunity to gather in a safe & respectful environment consistent with Governor Lee's standing Executive Orders for Tennessee. As a result, attendance will be limited and reservations will be on a first-come, first-served basis. So look for your invitation email in the coming weeks and . . . . . if you are inclined to attend, please respond promptly. You don't want to miss out! Monthly New Villagers Socials are a great way to meet other New Villagers, learn about all that East Tennessee has to offer, and engage with your new community. The circle of friends you develop here will be with you throughout your tenure in Shangri-La! We are your portal to the social fabric of Tellico Village!




#### John & Margie Rhode
