March Events will be opening on Friday the 5th.

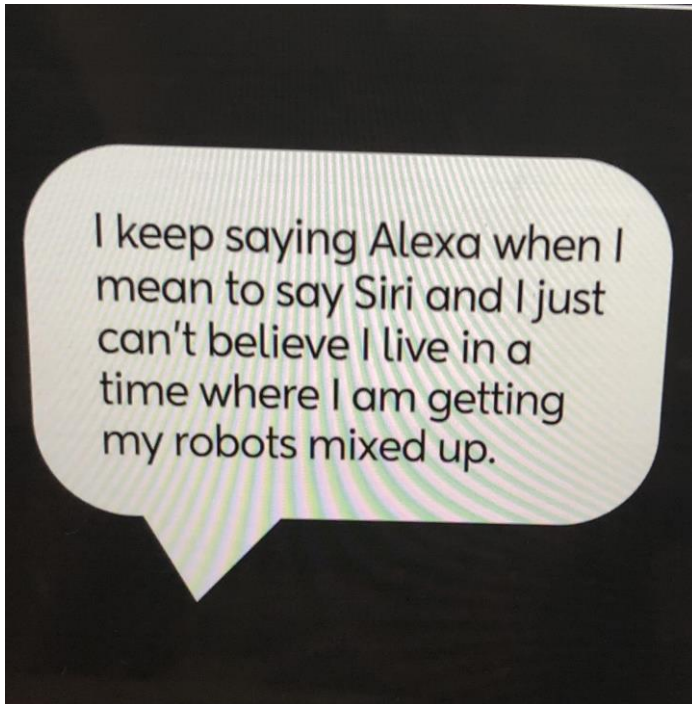
We have **Bowling**, and **NV Mini Golf** again.

TVCUC provides members with a means to enhance their practical understanding of technology and the ability to better use their PCs, Macs, tablets and smartphones. One of the primary member benefits is the First Level Support (FLS) team, which quickly responds to members' technology questions when something goes wrong with their computers or other devices. FLS provides FREE assistance using TeamViewer remote control software, so problems can be resolved without coming to a member's home during the pandemic. The TVCUC is always adding new educational resources, such How-To articles and videos to their website, and Special Interest Groups for topics like "Smart Home" and "Cord Cutting" are coming soon. The club's Technology Access Program (TAP) continues to be a nationally recognized outreach program. From inception in 2007 through December 2020, TAP has refurbished and delivered 8,355 computer systems that have benefited 12,460 youths.
