For starters, the January Social has been canceled. Governor Lee has put limits on gathering and we want to keep everyone safe.

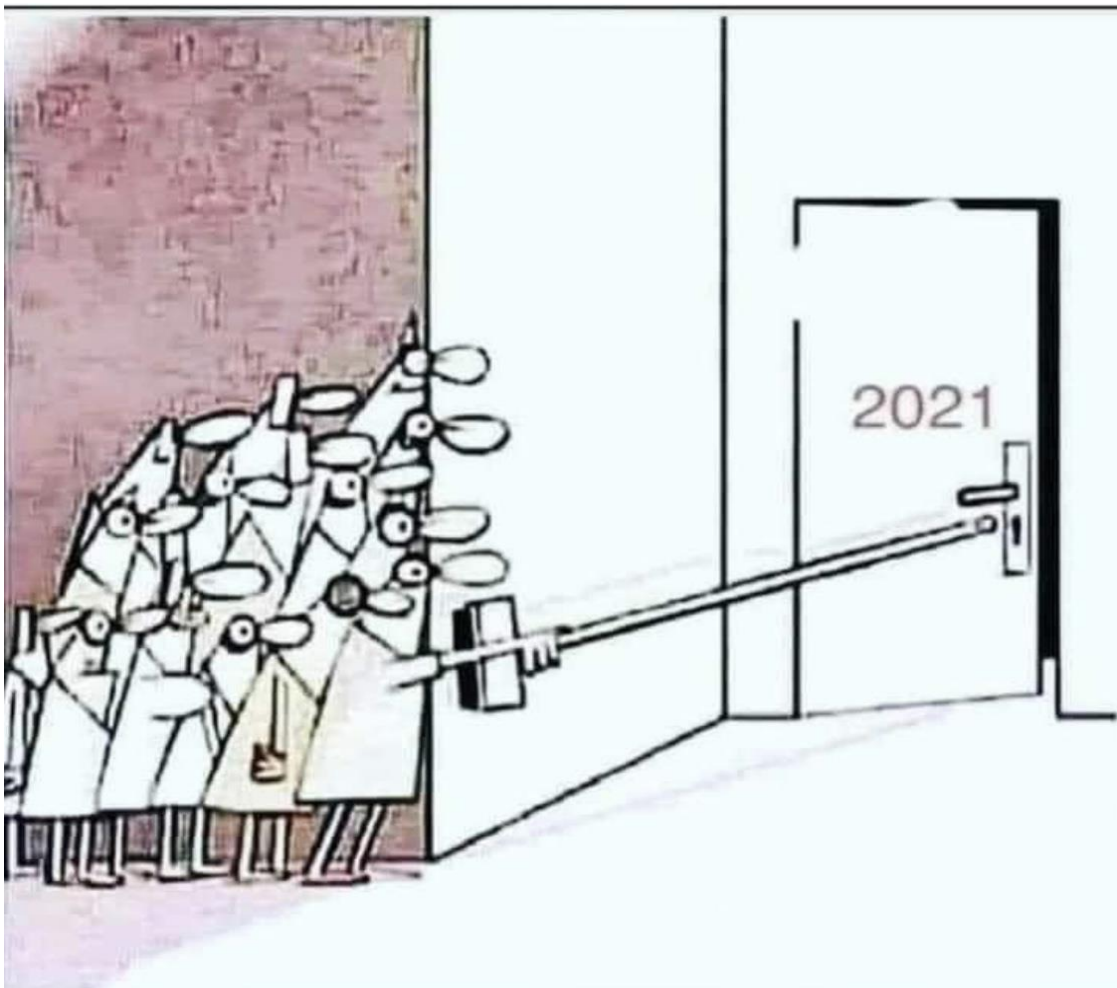
