Ijams Nature Center

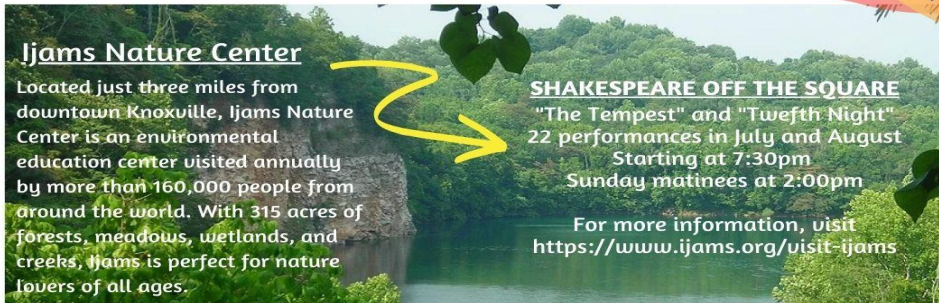
