Hosts will coordinate a date, time, and duration and arrange food and beverage offerings of their choosing.

One of the most popular activities in the village! Wine groups are casual and fun and a great way to meet your neighbors and make new friends.

Groups range in size from 5-7 households (1-2 people each) and meet monthly in members' homes. Each household brings a bottle of wine or beverage of your choice.

Hosts determine the theme of their choice, and all households take turns at hosting. It's that simple!
