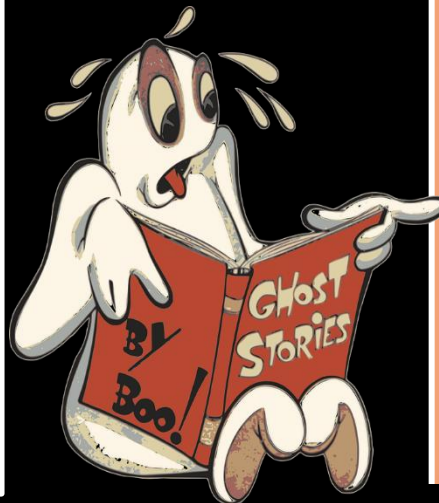


DINNER PARTIES
