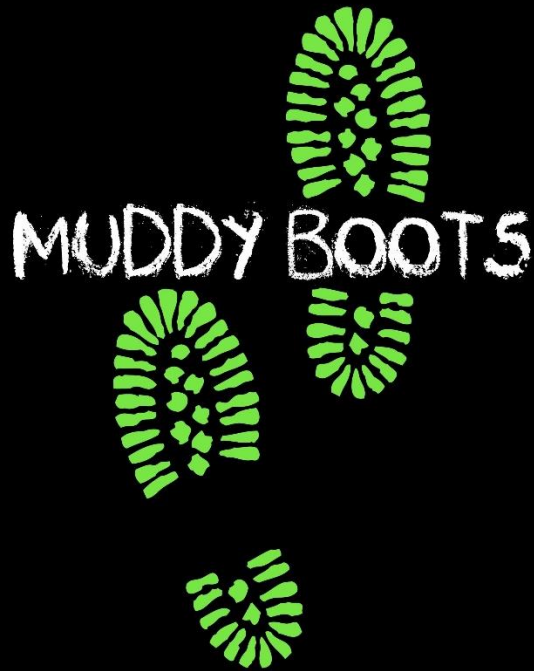

The Department of Energy (DOE) Public Bus Tour is a one-of-a-kind tour that visits the three primary sites of the Manhattan Project in Oak Ridge, TN. Each tour includes two guides to help share the unique scientific history of the Secret City with visits to the Y-12 New Hope Center. (The facility houses the spacious History Center featuring displays about the Manhattan Project, the Cold War, and other Y-12 missions), ORNL's historic Graphite Reactor (A national historic landmark it served as the pilot project that led to the first production of plutonium. Visitors will view the world's oldest nuclear reactor), and the K-25 History Center (learn about the gaseous diffusion process that enriched uranium (later sent to Y-12 for further enrichment) to power the first atomic bomb). Tour guides provide historical narrative along with information about current activities related to research and development, national security, and environmental clean-up. Guests returned to AMSE by 12:30 and have admission to the museum for the rest of the business day.

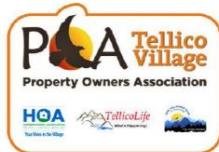

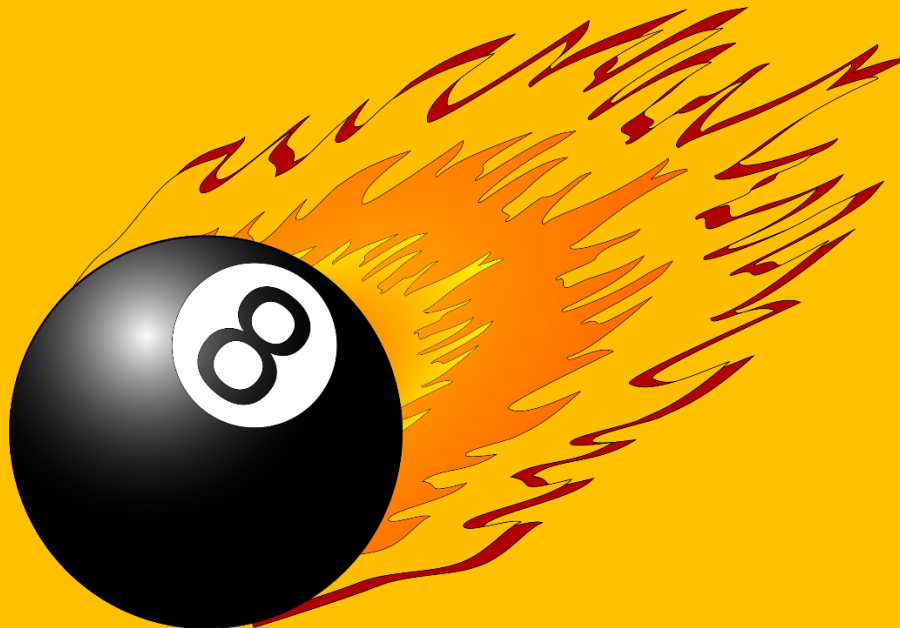
