JULY 2023 BOARD OF DIRECTORS MESSAGE

New Villagers Board of Directors Call for Volunteers, Nominations

We have all heard that Tellico Village runs on volunteers. That is so true. The only paid employees are a part of the POA. And even the POA is overseen by an all-volunteer Board of Directors. Both the HOA and New Villagers (NV) are 100% volunteer organizations. True also for the Fire Department, the Library, etc., etc. As such, NV is limited to two-year memberships and Director positions turn over each and every year. That means new volunteers are needed all the time. Volunteers are the life blood and engine that powers New Villagers. This is how it works for NV according to our By-Laws:

Article VI – Nominations and Elections

The Board of Directors, plus at least one representative from the general membership, shall be the nominating committee. The Club President will ask for volunteers for the representative on the nominating committee and candidates for board positions at the May general meeting. The Board may ask each candidate to provide a resume and statement addressing why he or she is seeking the position. The current Board will review the nominating committee and board position candidates to ensure their qualifications and readiness for the positions. The nominating committee shall present a slate of known candidates at the July general meeting and send electronically to all new members by email through the first New Villager Newsletter following the July meeting /social. Additional members interested in volunteering for a board position should contact a board member and provide a resume and statement addressing why he or she is seeking the position. The nominating committee will review all the candidates and select the recommended candidate for each board position at the August board meeting. Such publication may be electronic. The Membership will vote on the proposed slate at the September general meeting.

Election shall be by voice or hand vote unless a request is made for a secret ballot by a majority vote of the membership present at the meeting. The term of office shall coincide with the organization's fiscal year. If a vacancy occurs during an officer's term, the Board of Directors shall appoint a replacement.

Nominations and candidates have been sought for the last few months and many more are needed for the Board positions. The positions and Directors are listed toward the end of this newsletter. Without volunteers, NV will struggle to exist. Please consider volunteering.

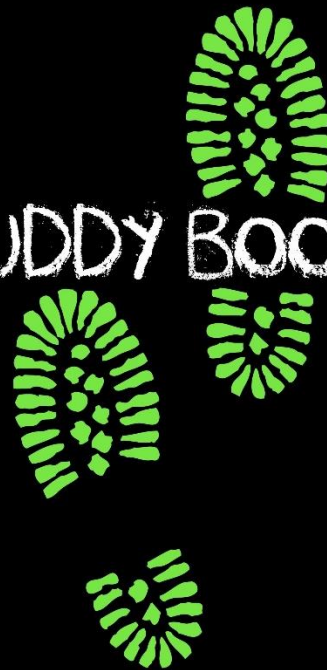
