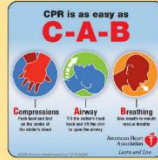

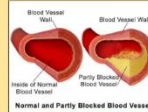

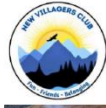
"The Best Hot Dog You Can Buy In Tellico Village!"

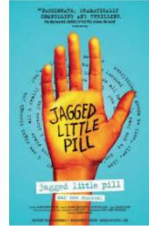
Fat Dog Hot Dogs is open to the public. You do not have to be playing golf to enjoy these delicious hot dogs. Come on by!

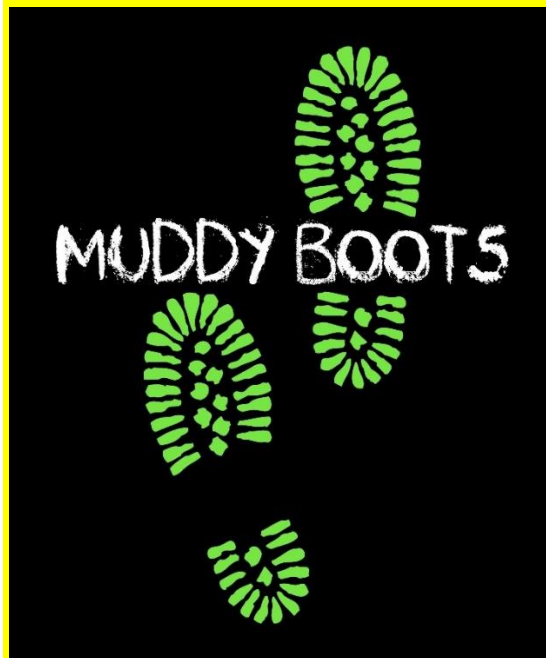

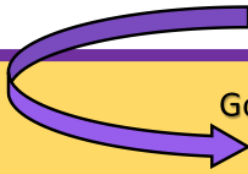
