## IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW:

- Coming to socials lets you meet new friends, sign up for activities such as dinner parties, wine groups, game groups, and learn about many clubs who have information tables! Come early (4:30 or 6:00pm) and stop by tables and get information about the fun they offer.
- If you sign up for a 5:00pm or 6:30pm social, put it on your calendar and come **at that time** as seats are limited, especially for the 5:00pm session. Register anytime for next month's social the day after each month's social meeting (Friday) when many events open for registration, too!
- If you don't come to a social, you won't have a chance to win any of the prizes being given away each time! Your chances of winning are greater at the second session as fewer attend it.
- **Feb 6 is the POA, HOA, and NV New Resident Orientation Meeting. It is held bi-monthly and you can register by clicking the link in the event table or on the Tellico Life Calendar for Feb.6.**
- On Thursdays, you can register vehicles, get license plates, and transfer titles right here in the village! A county clerk is here from 9am to 3:30pm (closed 1-1:45pm for lunch). Go to Berkshire Hathaway/Lakeside Realty office across from TV Welcome Center and ask for the County Clerk.
