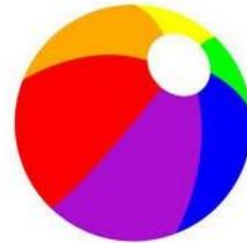

FACTS ABOUT OVARIAN CANCER

- 1 in 75 women will get ovarian cancer
- 5th leading cause of cancer related deaths in women
- Nearly 70% of women are diagnosed in advanced stages
- Deadliest of the gynecologic cancers
- Five year survival rate for women with advanced stages is 17%

AWARENESS ABOUT OVARIAN CANCER

- * The PAP test does not detect Ovarian Cancer
- * There is NO early detection or effective screening tool
- * Ovarian Cancer is NOT always hereditary
- * There is no way to prevent Ovarian Cancer

KNOW YOUR BODY FOR SIGNS WHICH

MAY BE:

- * Bloating
- * Pelvic or abdominal pain
- * Difficulty eating or feeling full quickly
- * Urinary symptoms (urgency or frequency) or unexplained bleeding
