On behalf of the Tellico New Villagers Club, I extend a heartfelt welcome! We are thrilled to have you join us. As you begin to settle in, we encourage you to explore all that our vibrant community has to offer. There is something for everyone here.

To help you get acclimated to the Village, we suggest the following to get started:

- **New Villagers Socials:** These monthly socials are a wonderful way to meet other newcomers and learn about the various clubs and special events that are available.
- **The Tellico Life Website:** There are valuable resources which provide information on upcoming events, club schedules, and community news. Check out the Calendar of Events on our web site (www.tellicolife.org/nv--home-page), it can be filtered for just New Villager activities. After logging in, you can click on the event, review the details to ensure it's something you want to do, and then click to sign up. to the event coordinator to be put on a wait list.
- **Tellico Welcome Center:** The Welcome Center has new homeowner packets with lots of information about everything from garbage collection to how your street name is pronounced.
- **Name Badges:** At the Tellico Library, you can order the badges. There is a small fee and a few options for colors. At social events it is customary to wear a name badge.
- **Villager Cards:** business cards with your contact information and a picture. Exchanging cards with others is a great way to remember names and faces of the new people you meet. Vista Print and Walgreens are a couple of sources for these.

One of our core beliefs is that community involvement enriches the lives of our residents. We encourage you to connect with your neighbors, make new friends, and explore Tennessee.

Volunteers Needed

It is time for us to start identifying potential board members for 2026 to carry the torch for this great and valuable organization. Our board members are all volunteers and serve a one calendar year term. As you enjoy the benefits of the New Villagers Club think about how you can apply your backgrounds, talents and energy to make the club even better. Consider volunteering for a board position starting in 2026. If you are interested in volunteering just reach out to any board member. By volunteering to become a board member you will become eligible for a NV membership extension to allow you to serve through 2026.

Board Roles - The Board meets monthly for 2 hours. There's a little bit of prep time for each Board Member, as each one reports on their area at the meeting. These are the Director Roles:

- a. **President** - runs the monthly board meetings, including working with the Secretary to prepare the agenda, and review draft minutes from each meeting. President also attends several other board meetings, including the Tellico Life Board meeting.
- i. **VP Activities** - runs the Event Coordinator Team (anywhere from 5-30 people who volunteer to run one of more events during the year). Coordinates all ECs, reviews each event Proposal and Costs, may engage Treasurer for reviews. Participates in the Monthly social introducing upcoming events.
- c. **VP Socials** - responsible for coordinating all aspects of each monthly Social including the overall agenda, coordinating with VP Activities on Event tables, and coordinates with all other TV clubs who introduce themselves to NV members at the Social.
- d. **VP Membership** - reports on Membership at monthly Board meetings, works with the POA Marketing department to understand trends of people moving into the Village. Assists with Monthly Socials, as the the main contact for those signing up to attend. Introduces all new Club Members at the monthly social.
- e. **VP Communications** - prepares and distributes Newsletters to New Villagers twice per month, and any special email blasts to provide updates on the club's events.
- f. **VP Technology** - manages the electronic filing system (DropBox), maintains the email addresses for board members, updates/maintains the New Villagers Website and updates to the NV Club parts of Tellico Life.
- g. **VP Finances (Treasurer)** - maintains the books and records for the Club, pays bills, reconciles bank accounts, reports on financials to the Board each month, provides different areas with a view of their respective revenues and expenses as needed.

If there's a particular Board Role you might want to volunteer for, we can share a more detailed "job description" and talk further.


